

CORPORATE PROFILE

ROR Power develops and operates renewable, sustainable energy through its portfolio of run-of-river and biomass projects in British Columbia. The company has four projects located in the upper Mamquam watershed near Squamish, BC.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

- Located approximately 70 km north of Vancouver in the Sea to Sky corridor near Squamish, BC
- 177 GWh of annual energy
- Interconnection: ~ 28 km of 138kV powerline
